RE: *March 2011 LEA Medicaid Report: Federal Reimbursement for Administrative and Direct Service Claiming (3rd Quarter 2011)*

The Quarterly Medicaid Direct Services Claiming report and the Quarterly Medicaid Administrative Claiming report are enclosed. The direct service report represents **federal Medicaid** reimbursement received by each participating LEA for direct services in state fiscal years 1993-2011; and the administrative claiming report represents **federal Medicaid** reimbursements received in state fiscal years 2001-2011. *Except for fiscal year 2011*, all state fiscal year reporting is complete, representing claims processed between July 1 and June 30 for each fiscal year. Reimbursements for state fiscal year 2011 represents claims processed between July 1, 2010 and March 31, 2011.

Since the last update:

- New Shoreham is enrolled and had its first claims processed in this quarter.
- There are 45 LEAs enrolled as providers representing: **all** 39 cities and towns; the East Bay Educational Collaborative; the Rhode Island School for the Deaf; William M. Davies Career and Technical School; The Metropolitan Career and Technical Center; Paul E. Cuffee; Kingston Hill Academy; Compass; International; Highlander; Blackstone Academy; Beacon; Democracy Prep; and Segue Institute for Learning Public Charter Schools.
- Since 1993, 45 LEAs have received an aggregate of direct services claiming reimbursement of \$244.8 million.
- Since 2001, 44 LEAs have received an aggregate of administrative claiming reimbursement of \$54.9 million.
- Reimbursement data is being shared with the School for the Deaf (their reimbursements are processed through a transfer of funds)
